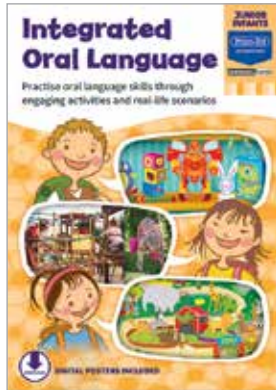

**THEMED ACTIVITIES**

**OUTCOME 13: Information giving, explanation and justification**

**ACTIVITY 1: TAKE A STAND (whole class and small groups)**

- Look at the picture. Ask the following questions: What words describe this bedroom? How is it different or the same as your bedroom?
- Draw an imaginary line across the largest open space in the classroom. Place signs with 'I agree', 'I disagree', and 'I'm not sure' evenly across the space, as shown. Say to the class: 'I don't think this is a very nice bedroom. I don't think I'd like this to be my bedroom.' Children think about the statements and decide if they agree, disagree or aren't sure. Then they stand near the most appropriate sign that reflects their decision.
- Select a number of different children to say why they made that decision.

**Additional outcomes: 1, 2 and 3, 5 and 6, 7**

**OUTCOME 14: Description, prediction and reflection**

**ACTIVITY 2: PAIRED INTERVIEW (whole class)**

- Look at the picture as a class and name the objects.
- Ask the questions: Is this bedroom tidy or messy? What things in the picture tell you that? What does the child who owns this bedroom need to do to make it tidy? Do you keep your bedroom tidy? How do you keep it tidy? How could you make it tidier? Form pairs so children can ask each other the last three questions.

**OUTCOMES 5 & 6: Acquisition and use of vocabulary**

**ACTIVITY 1: WORD CHARADES (small groups)**

- Pupils select words associated with the photograph and act them out for their group. A class word wall can be compiled and used as a word bank for pupils to refer to.

**(Additional Outcome 8)**

**OUTCOME 13: Information giving, explanation and justification**

**ACTIVITY 2: WHAT GOOD IS A TREE? (small groups)**

- Pupils watch a clip from *The Lorax* at <https://tinyurl.com/y7blucax>, and in small groups discuss whether a living tree or a tree like the oak-a-matic is better. Pupils record their final decision and justification using an audio or video recorder, or present their argument to the class.

**(Additional Outcomes 1, 2 & 3, 4, 5 & 6, 14)**

**OUTCOME 7: Demonstration of understanding**

**ACTIVITY 3: DRAW A TREE (pairs)**

- Pupils take turns to give their partner instructions on drawing a tree of their own design. Pupil one designs and draws a tree then describes to their partner how to draw it, without their partner seeing their design. Pupils can then swap roles.

Each poster can be downloaded and displayed on an Interactive whiteboard, making it easy for teachers to use it for whole-class teaching or in station teaching.

The posters contain a mixture of colourful art and real-life photographs to engage pupils and encourage discussion.

The themes have been chosen to assist teachers approach oral language as a discrete lesson, while simultaneously allowing teachers to integrate most curricular areas, such as SPHE, geography, history, mathematics and science.

Many of the posters can be used to integrate both the English and Irish languages, as the images selected lend themselves to language development in Gaeilge.

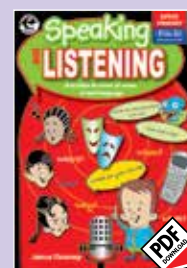
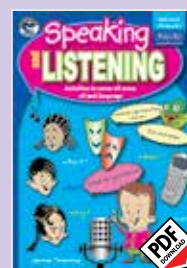
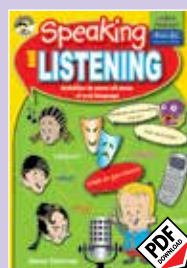

**ACTIVITY 3: Feed the Monster**


**Materials required:** Large cardboard cutout of a monster, firmly attached to the end of a shoebox; blank squares of different coloured cardboard (one for each different sound used.)

**Instructions:** Decide on a simple two-sound word such as on, at, is or a CVC (consonant/vowel/consonant) word such as box, hat, cat to demonstrate the process.

Say the individual sounds that make up the word, and as each sound is stated, 'feed' one coloured square of cardboard into the monster's mouth.

Refer to page 20 for an example of a monster outline to use.

\* For those children who are developing letter/sound correspondence, individual sounds written on cards may be used.



**ACTIVITY 4: What Word is That?**


**Materials required:** Pictures of simple, familiar objects

**Instructions:** Place three different picture cards face up on the floor and ask the children to name each one. Explain that you are going to say the sounds that name one picture. Say each sound in the chosen words, stretching out the sounds then blending them to make the word.

The children have to point to the picture that matches the word.

Encourage the children to repeat the sounds and 'run them together' to make the word. Repeat a number of times using different pictures.

This activity is best carried out in small groups. Refer to page 21 for some pictures to use.

### MEET THE AUTHOR

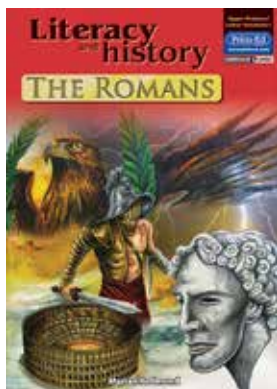
